- Submissions will be in APA 7th edition format to include:
 - \rightarrow A cover page
 - \rightarrow Maximum three (3) pages of content
 - ✤ References page
 - → An abstract is NOT required
- > The instructor will provide a question, case study or article for students to research and critically analyze.
- Students must cite a minimum of three (3) professional, scholarly, or academic journals written within the past five years in researching and responding to the questions. However, the student may need to read more than three sources to respond to the questions effectively. The textbook may be cited in the paper; however, it will not count toward the three required sources.
 - → Students may use Wikipedia, SKYbrary, or other Wiki sites or blogs/vlogs as a general guide to generate ideas for these papers or search for credible resources. However, students MAY NOT use these as primary resources or references for these papers. Anything found on these sites must be verified by other credible professional or academic journals.
