

Purpose

You are the key person, the only one who can bring your speech to life. Delivery is vital to the overall speech success. There are several things that can go wrong during a presentation and are beyond your control (e.g., physical and external distractions, audience reactions, etc.). Your readiness, preparedness, and fluency are within your control. It is up to you how rehearsed you will be.
